**DESCRIPTION: USING HANDWRITING ANALYSIS FOR VOIR DIRE AND EVALUATION OF OTHER PERSONS IN THE TRIAL** Using strokes of handwriting and their related personality traits to help select jurors and to evaluate other counsel, parties, clients, key witnesses and others. Emphasis on detecting particular jurors, such as those that are open-minded, rigid thinkers, swayed by emotion, overly analytical, mentally slow, and those that defy or won't listen.

**HANDWRITING ANALYSIS AND THE LAW** What handwriting analysis is and why it is valid, reliable, and useful for trial and other areas in the law. Overview of how the law impacts handwriting analysis, particularly on issues of invasion of privacy, copyright infringement, defamation, and the discrimination laws, such as disabilities protection.

**FORENSIC DOCUMENT EXAMINATION:** learn what this field of legal expertise covers and how a document examiner does the work. A document examiner is one who is called to answer questions related to authorship and authenticity. This will examine common questions that are usually brought to the attorney's office: Were the entries written separately or sequentially? Was a page added to a completed contract? What is under "white out/black out"? What indented writing may be left on a paper? Who authored an anonymous writing? Who really signed the deed, will, etc.? Practical experiments will test your skill!
