The United States Probation Office, Charleston, South Carolina, will host a **Federal Sentencing Guidelines Seminar for Attorneys** on September 25, 2008, from 8:30 am until 5:00 pm. The seminar will be held at *The Citadel* in room 165, Bond Hall, and will be conducted by officers of the U.S. Probation Office's Presentence Unit, along with guest presenters. Parking is available behind Caper's Hall (next door to Bond Hall) in Lot "A."

This seminar is provided for members of the South Carolina Bar practicing in the United States District Court, and is requisite for those considering practicing in the District Court for inclusion on the CJA panel list. Seminar participants will be awarded 6.5 hours of CLE credit by the Supreme Court of South Carolina Commission on Continuing Legal Education and Specialization. The 6.5 hours includes 1.0 hour of ethics training.
