Coggiola's Warnings Regarding Social Networking Sites

It's the kind of warning you hope most lawyers wouldn't need. Lesley M. "Lee" Coggiola knows some do.

During a recent speech on professionalism at the Charleston School of Law, Ms. Coggiola, disciplinary counsel for the South Carolina Supreme Court, warned that being on-line doesn't mean being out of mind. She cautioned lawyers against using email, Facebook, and other social networking sites in ways that could come back to haunt them.

She cited cases involving a South Carolina attorney and a judge who "friended" each other on Facebook, and an Illinois public defender who trashed his clients. "Do not talk about your client. Do not lie. Do not talk about judges," she advised. "Do not ask for a continuance for a funeral and then post skiing photos."

"What's out on Facebook is out there for everyone to see, and those are the kinds of things we're seeing." In fact, her office is seeing these things so much that she was asked to address the issue at the South Carolina Judicial Conference this summer. As for emails, she referred to a recent disciplinary case she handled that involved inappropriate electronic messages sent between attorneys. The conversation evolved into a back-and-forth of insults aimed at each other and the families they represented. She offered a tip that any lawyer these days should keep in mind regarding inappropriate emails: "Just don't do it." Ms. Coggiola said, "If you're writing in all caps, you're probably yelling."
